## ZAMBIA-ZIMBABWE TRIP

### August 28-September 10, 2018

The Outreach Foundation takes groups out to see how God is at work through partners. This trip will introduce travelers to partners serving the Lord faithfully in Zambia and Zimbabwe. Also traveling with us will be Rev. Ted and Sue Wright, former missionaries in Southern Africa.

Our first stop in Zimbabwe will introduce you to the CCAP Harare Synod, the Home of Hope and the presbytery of Zimbabwe (POZ) to meet our former Lovemore Home boys. Then we will fly to Lusaka/ Zambia on September 2<sup>nd</sup> from Harare.

Upon arrival in Lusaka, we'll tour Justo Mwale University, which is also where we'll lodge. We will meet Presbyterian students from Justo Mwale sponsored by U.S. congregations through Outreach. We will also visit Christian Alliance for Children, a partner in caring for vulnerable children (House of Moses and Bill and Bette Bryant Crisis Nursery) in Lusaka. We will visit and learn more about the CCAP Community Schools in addition to meeting with leaders of the Church of Central Africa Presbyterian.

We will include a visit to Namumu Orphanage Center in Siavonga where we will spend approximately two days

hosted by Rev. Charles Ngoma of the Reformed Church of Zambia, Siavonga congregation. While in Siavonga, we will have an opportunity to meet and visit St. Mark Presbyterian Church hosted by a long-time friend, Munjongo Namuyamba.

The basic trip cost is \$1,600 and includes meals, lodging, and transportation. It does not include international airfare, visas, travel insurance (required), offerings/gifts.

A \$150 non-refundable deposit and trip application to hold a place on the trip must be received by **June 1, 2018**. You will obtain a Zambian and Zimbabwean visa upon arrival.
